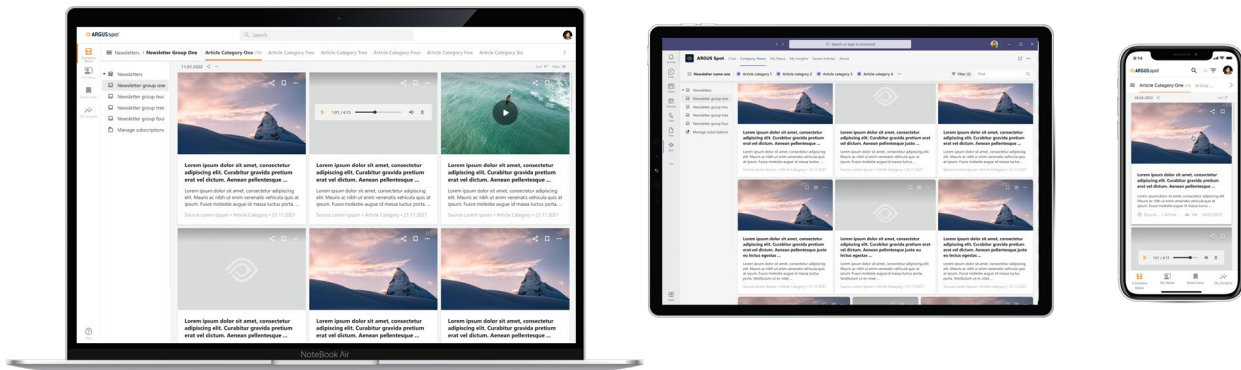

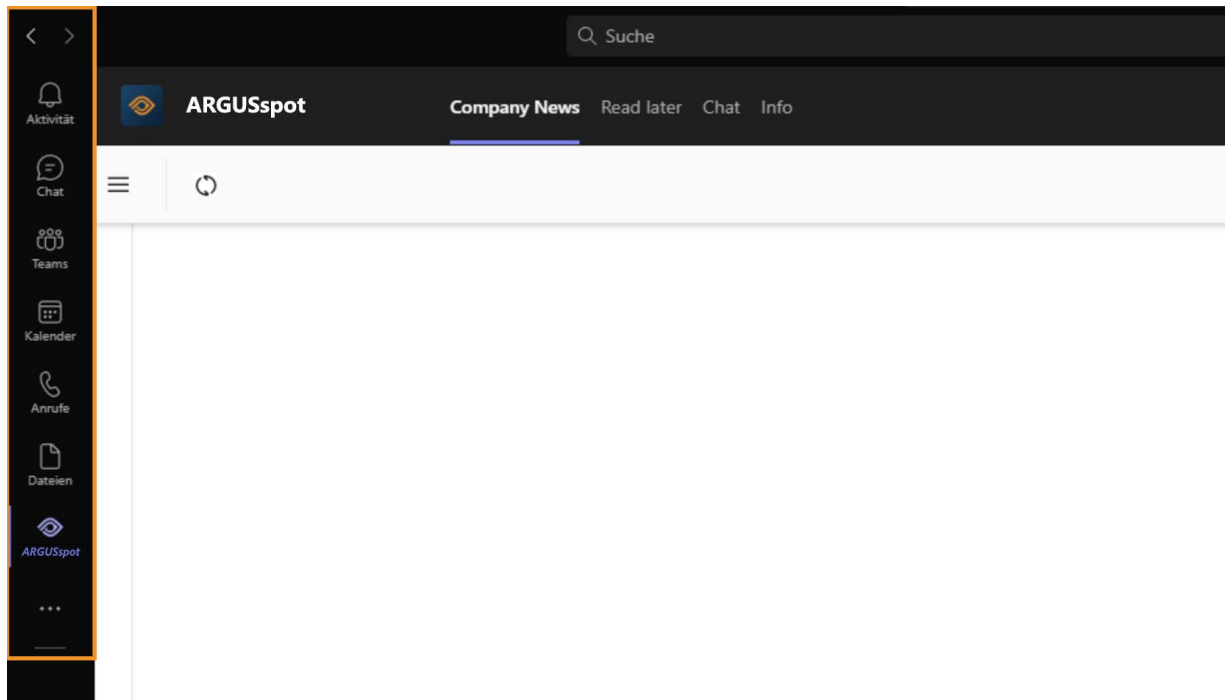

## 1. Introduction

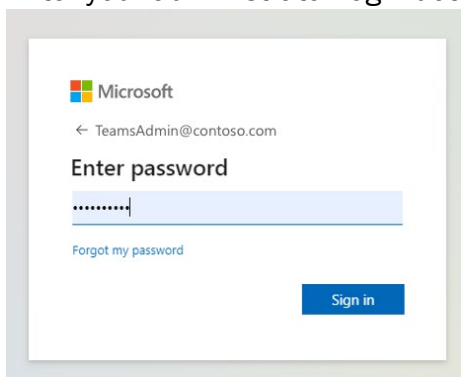
The aim is to make the **ARGUSspot** Microsoft Teams app available for users by having the app pinned and permanently displayed in Microsoft Teams without users having to integrate the app themselves.



## 2. Instructions for Microsoft 365 administrators

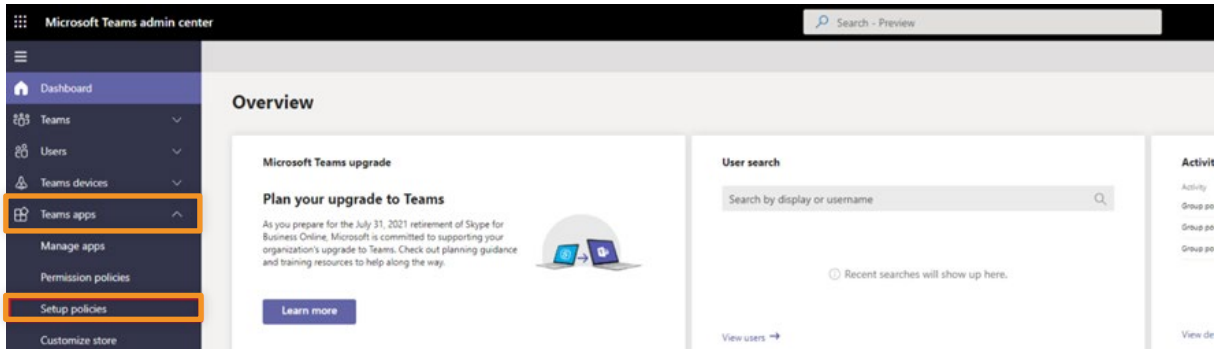
### 2.1 Logging in to the Microsoft Teams admin centre

1. Go to <https://admin.teams.microsoft.com/>
2. Enter your administrator login details.

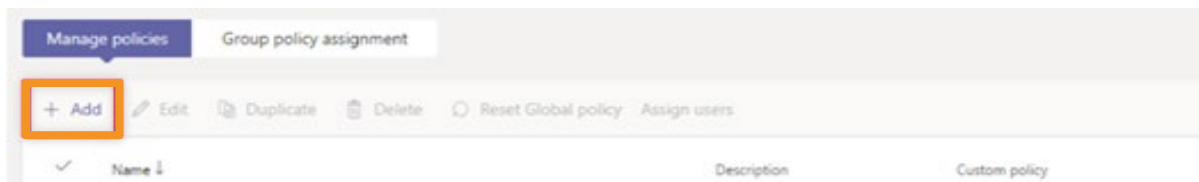


## 2.2 Setup policies

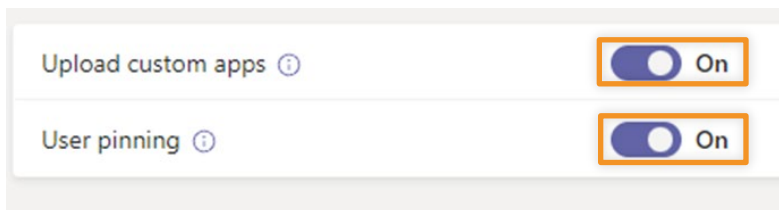
3. Open the **'Teams apps'** drop down in the menu ribbon and click on **'Setup policies'**.



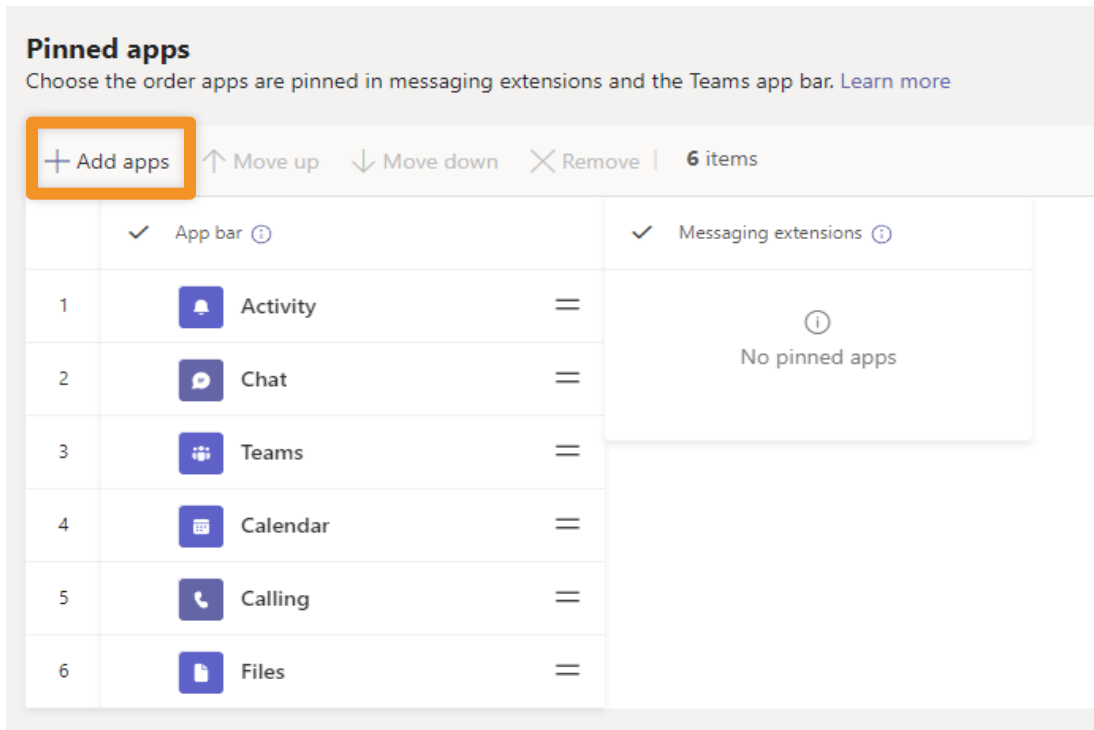
4. Add a setup policy by clicking on **'+ Add'**.



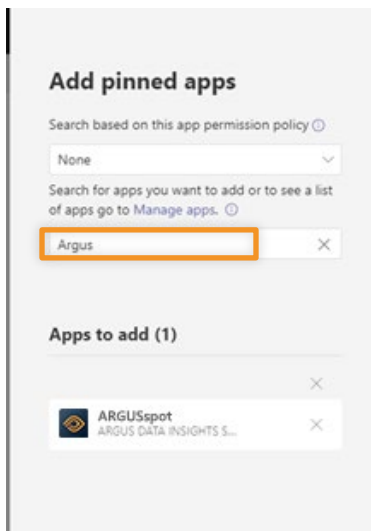
5. Check that **'Upload custom apps'** and **'User pinning'** are enabled.



- Under 'Pinned apps', select 'Add apps'.



- You can search for the required app or the permission policy in the 'Add pinned apps' column. Confirm by clicking on 'Add'.



- You can now find the required app under **'Pinned apps'**. You can move the apps around depending on how you want them to be displayed in Teams. Finally, save your settings by clicking on **'Save'**.
